MOT recognizes that many of us have had our vaccinations for COVID-19. However, with the rapid rise of the COVID Delta variant infections throughout our community, the Detroit Opera House will again require mask wearing in our facility until further notice, as follows:

At this time it is our policy for every person who enters the Detroit Opera House, regardless of vaccination, to wear a mask while in the common areas of the building. These include lobbies, hallways, restrooms, elevators, and other shared spaces.

When visitors and employees reach their destination space in the Opera House, they may elect to wear masks or not, at their own discretion, unless otherwise posted. We encourage everyone to remain masked, even in the destination space.

It is our belief that practicing this policy will be in the best interest of everyone. Everyone's health matters. We apologize for any inconvenience, but please understand that, for now, mask-wearing is required of everyone in hallways, elevators, lobbies and other common areas of the Detroit Opera House.
